Family Camp July 3 – July 5, 2015 All ages Cost varies This is an open family camp for anyone who wants to get away from the summer heat for July 4<sup>th</sup>. Hiking, campfires, s'mores, songs, games, low-ropes course, archery, basketball, relaxation, ahhhhh. We have an a la carte cost sheet to account for size of family, size of cabin, etc. However, for cabins/food it usually boils down to about \$90/adults and teenagers, \$45/kids 4-10, and free for toddlers. For the Lodge (more like a bed & breakfast setting), the cost is a little more. We'll help you figure it all out. MaryLou Chopelas, Camp Director.

The cost is only \$15/year for students, \$50/year for adults, and \$80/year for families including t-shirts and water bottles. Do the math. You will see that this is a bargain compared to the non-member price.

## What's included?

Cabins with bunk-beds, heat, lights, electricity, bath-house with hot showers and real plumbing, all (really good) meals, fireplace, piano, basketball court, archery, low-ropes course, hiking, arts & crafts building, lots of pine trees, and fire circle with bench seating. Lodge accommodations optional.

### Who are we?

We are a 501.c.3 non-profit Christian-based camp which was previously owned by the United Methodist South District. The camp was built over 60 years ago and continues to change lives for all in southwest Arizona just as it has for generations.

### Where are we?

One hour south of Willcox in the Chiricahua Mountains. We'll give you driving directions.
