Peanut Butter and Jelly Sandwich Making – For those of you who plan far ahead on your calendars, we will be scheduling our final sandwich making event of the year on Friday afternoon, November 15th. Again, we will attempt to make 500 or more sandwiches in just a few hours. These sandwiches will be delivered to the Casa Maria Soup Kitchen, where they will be added to sack lunches for those living with hunger. Stand by for further information.

Primavera Men's Shelter – The shelter remodeling is complete and is now housing approximately 55 homeless men who will be attending our monthly dinner. We shop, cook, serve, and fellowship with the men at the Primavera shelter on the 4th Saturday of each month. Our work teams of volunteers are set for October and November, but we will definitely need to recruit at least 4 volunteers for our December 28th meal. We cook and serve a great meal to men living with homelessness and they greatly appreciate our efforts. The meals are planned in advance and the grocery shopping is done by team leaders. New volunteers are always paired with experienced volunteers. The work involves standing and lifting, cooking, and serving. All volunteers who are vaccinated, gloved, and over the age of 12 are welcome.

Casa Maria Soup Kitchen – Our final mission outreach of the year at Casa Maria will be early on Saturday morning, November 16th. We need 3 or 4 volunteers who will cook and serve our excellent chicken-vegetable soup. This is an early morning mission outreach where we shop, cook, and serve 200 - 300 bowls of soup for our neighbors. We start very early, (approximately 6:30 am), and we finish by approximately 10:30 am. This work involves standing, lifting, cooking, and serving, using large commercial pots in a very small kitchen.
